ACCEPTED MATERIALS

• Construction, Renovation and Demolition (CRD)

Natural wood, painted or treated, windows, doors, gypsum, plaster, toilets, sinks, furniture, ceramics, asphalt shingles, mineral wool, insulation, composites of various materials, wooden pallets.

Cardboard

Rolls, boxes, packaging, egg cartons

• Recyclable materials

Containers and empty plastic bottles (numbered 1 to 7), styrofoam, food or molded, clean bags and wrapping foils (in a knotted bag), glass bottles and jars (without cap and lid), metal caps and lids and plastic, paper (sheets, envelopes and bags), newspapers, circulars, magazines, yearbooks, books, etc.

• Granular materials

Brick, concrete, asphalt, rubble, rock (max. 30 cm in diameter), sand, aggregate, crushed stone, rock and uncontaminated earth.

• Iron metals

Iron, washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, barbecues, sheet metal, empty paint containers, electrical wires, clotheslines, clothes hangers, brooches.

• Non-ferrous metals

Aluminum, copper, lead, zinc, etc.

• Used tires

Tires with or without rims. Inside diameter of up to 24.5 inches and an outside diameter of up to 48.5 inches.

• Flexible and rigid plastics

Containers, tarpaulins, awnings, pool cloths, garden hoses, house coverings, patio furniture, PVC pipes, empty bags of fertilizer, soil, wood pellets, etc.

Household hazardous waste (HHW)

Batteries and batteries, wax, glue, fondue fuel, paint thinner, antifreeze, aerosols (insecticide, oil, insulation foam, etc.), chlorine, batteries, pesticides, scaler, cleaners, ammonia, acids, bases, etc.

IMPORTANT NOTE: HHWs must be clearly identified if they are not in their original containers.

Paintings

Paints and varnishes for domestic use (latex, alkyd, enamel or other) aerosol paints.

• Used oils and vegetable oils

Oils, filters, containers and aerosols.

Propane and butane

1 lb to 100 lb propane tanks, camping burners, butane lighters, aerosols, fire extinguishers,

etc.

• Green residues

Branches, tree trunks, stumps, shrubs, leaves, garden waste, plants and grass clippings, peat pieces.

• Recyclable bulbs

Fluocompact types (twisted) and fluorescent tubes.

• Small mechanical appliances

Old snowblowers, lawnmowers, power saws, trimmers, hedge trimmers, etc. IMPORTANT NOTE: Make sure the unit is completely drained of all oil and gasoline before bringing it to the ecocenter.

• Electronic and computer equipment

Computers and peripherals, televisions, telephones and answering machines, cellular devices, printers, etc.

Large non-metallic scrap

Furniture, couches, mattresses, carpets, showers, etc.

Used clothing and other objects

Clothing, toys, books and other small items that can be reused.
